Riders Briefing

1. Parking for participants, families and supporters is located at Harvey Hadden Sports Village.
2. Volunteers will be on hand to direct cyclists and supporters from the car park to the cycle track.
3. Timekeepers and race organisers on the day are from British Cycling and are experienced in cycle racing. Please follow their instructions at all times.
4. Care should always be taken with bikes and other personal equipment, and it is suggested your bikes are locked up if left alone.
5. The circuit itself is 1.5Km a lap and riders should ride it anti-clockwise at all times.
6. The Harvey Hadden circuit is a public area and is commonly used by dog walkers and pedestrians as it includes a footpath through its centre. On the day the circuit will be marshalled, and access given to the public will be controlled. Access to the circuit will be given to cyclists, their families, supporters, and officials. Only cross the circuit road in the designated crossing places and always adhere to the advice of the marshals around the circuit.

7. Helmets should be used at all times for all competitors in both the Time Trial (TT) and the Road Race.

8. The TT event is being held on the same circuit as the road race.

9. On arrival at the circuit, can all riders sign on at the Registration desk. You will be given a race number to be worn/pinned to your lower back and a timing chip to be placed on the front left fork of your bike.

10. Changing facilities are available in the main Harvey Hadden building. Toilets are located in the same building or at the athletics track.

11. Registration will commence from 9:15am and racing (TT) will begin at 10.30am. Otherwise, Competitors should sign on at least 1 hour before their race.

12. The race officials will provide results of first second and third places to the Games organisers from each of the age groups. Medal ceremonies will take place in between TT races and the Road Race so please listen out for your age groups to be called up to the podium arch for the awards ceremony.

13. Racing should be completed by 4.00pm.
